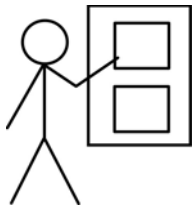

How the group will work (Rules)

1. Introduction

1.1 The What People Do Group is part of the Leicester City Learning Disability Partnership Board. 'What People Do' means

"What people do during the day, evening and at weekends"

1.2 The 'What People Do Group' joins together the Community Support Services, Person Centred Planning and Employment Action Group,

1.3 The 'What People Do' Group will try to improve people's lives by increasing opportunities into:

- Employment
- Voluntary Work
- Transport
- Hobbies
- Leisure Activities
- Learning
- Living life like anyone else

1.4 The 'What People Do Group' will work for people with Learning Disabilities that live in the city of Leicester

2. Who does the group answer to?

2.1 The 'What People Do Group' will tell the Leicester City Learning Disability Partnership Board what they have been doing.





2.2 The Group can discuss and develop any items that are linked to Employment, Community Support Services and Person Centred Planning.

2.3 The Group can have a say on all matters that need a decision.

3. Involving people (consultation)

3.1 The 'What People Do' Group will work in partnership with, and involve people with learning disabilities and carers to make sure their views are listened to.

3.2 The Group will link with, and involve the other working groups of the Learning Disability Partnership Board to take forward any work.

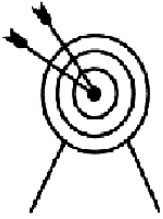
4. Who is on the group (membership)

4.1 People on the group will vote for a Chair-this person will lead the group. People on the group will vote for a Vice Chair - this person will lead the group when the Chair is away. Voting will take place once every 2 years.

4.2 People on the group should support decisions made and make sure things happen in their own organisation.

4.3 People on the group will be from:

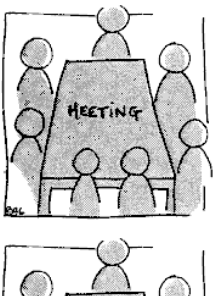
- We Think, We Think Too and Bright lights
- Carers Action Group
- Adults and Housing Department; Leicester City Council, (Neighbourhood Centres, Learning Disability Team, Planning Section, the Social Work Team, Health & Safety)
- The Health Service
- The Voluntary Sector
- Workforce Development



- Organisations that help people with disabilities to live fulfilling lives
- Leisure and School and Colleges
- Transport

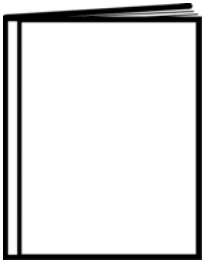
5. What the group will do? (aims)

- 5.1 The 'What People Do Group' will help and support people to have real opportunities and training.
- 5.2 The Group will decide what areas need to be developed. The group will share information and ideas on future work that will improve outcomes and choices for people with Learning Disabilities.
- 5.3 The Group will have an action plan, agreed by the Learning Disability Partnership Board.



6. Meetings

- 6.1 The What People Do Group will meet at least once every 6 to 8 weeks.
- 6.2 All meetings will be recorded and the minutes sent to all group members. The minutes of the meeting will be easy to understand.
- 6.3 The Chair, on behalf of the whole group, will take any decisions and ideas to organisations that can help to make things happen.
- 6.4 The group will check what actions have been agreed to see if they have been done. The group will check that things are still happening.
- 6.5 The Group will give the Learning Disability Partnership Board regular updates about the work that is happening.



- 6.6 The group will check:
- What work has been done or achieved
 - That it is still doing what it said it will do
 - That the right people are still on the group
 - That the work the group is doing is still necessary

This will then happen once a year.

7. 3 Year Plan

- More people will be in paid, real jobs
- Government (Health Service, Local Authority) will be employing more people with a learning disability in paid jobs
- More people will be doing college courses that will help them get real jobs and support them to live independently.
- People will be spending more time doing things they choose during the day, rather than going to the same place and getting bored. The right support will be available to help people do this.

7.1 There will be 4 groups that support the 'What People Do Group' action plan

The Groups will be

- Transport
- Employment including Voluntary Work
- Learning
- Social, Leisure, Sports and Hobbies

Each Group will have a chair and a vice chair
